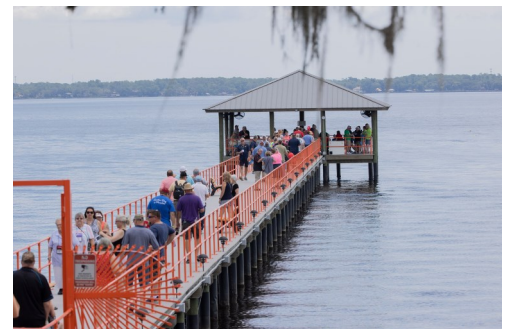




Moosehaven Celebrates 100 Years!

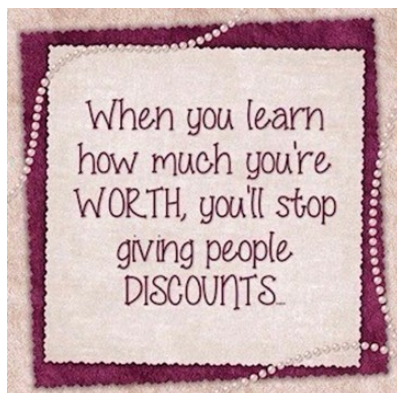

Children's Spooktacular Halloween Drive-Thru

From our Past Governor Alan AuBuchon:

I had the privilege of being the Governor of this great Lodge for two years not too long ago. I have a lot of great memories of my time serving, along with the Board members that I was lucky enough to work with. I am proud of the things I was able to accomplish, but by far, my greatest accomplishment was the monument marking the entrance to the Moose Lodge tract in the Anchorage Downtown Cemetery. My wife Cristie first brought up the idea, and together we had some pretty crazy ideas, such as a life sized bronze moose.

Eventually, we settled on three different versions of the monument we have today. After discussing it with members of the Board, I eventually proposed the monument idea in our Board meeting, and it was approved by the Board and the General Membership with enthusiasm. Cristie and I had agreed to be responsible for all fundraising activities until it was paid for, and this was no easy task...as the monument's cost was close to \$10,000. As always, the Lodge, the Moose Legion, the Horseshoe League along with other lodges, were very generous. We had done some miscellaneous fundraisers, with some success, but the reality was, we were far short of our goal.

Enter Gary Morrell.

I, along with quite a few other Moose members, worked with Gary at NC Machinery for many years. Gary was always quick to donate his time and efforts to me or anyone who needed it. Gary was a shoulder for me to lean on when I lost my son, Chris, and he helped me immensely during that period.

Gary made a donation to our cause that was mind boggling. He donated everything in his garage for only a tax receipt (that was far below the value of all he gave us). It ranged from rare and valuable Fur Rendezvous items, Native artwork, and Remington sculptures! After showcasing the items for a week or so in the lodge, we had a very, very successful auction fundraiser. We not only raised the 10k, but we went over it by several thousand and had to eventually shut the auction down.

We paid for the monument, and the excess funds were used for members in distress.

I tried getting in contact with Gary a few days ago, (who lives in San Antonio now) hoping to stop and see him while we were in Texas, and his wife called me back and told me that Gary only had a couple of weeks to live, because of the cancer he was fighting. By the time you are reading this, Gary will have already passed. I know many of our lodge members have been to the Downtown Cemetery to see our monument, but if you haven't, I encourage you to go see it.

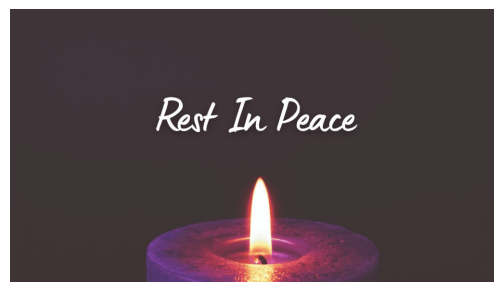
It is a beautiful legacy that will be there long after all of us are gone. Every time that I see it, I am reminded of the wonderful things that we can do when we all come together.
